Spring Clean Up Day and we'd love it if you lent a hand.

Here's how you can help!

Roadside pickup. We are looking to put together 60 teams of 5 people each, to adopt portions of roads for debris and trash pick up. You can adopt Village or county roads in Putnam Township or the Village. We will provide cleanup kits that include 5 trash bags, latex gloves and safety vests. Cleanup kits will be available for pick up at the Township Hall, starting at 10 a.m.

Junk removal. If you'd like to do a little spring cleaning of your own, we are placing roll-off dumpsters at the Putnam Township Hall parking lot. Residents of the Village and Putnam and Unadilla Townships are welcome to drop off household junk from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. We'll need volunteers here too, overseeing the dumpsters, to prevent dumping of prohibited items.

Roadside pickup. Available in Putnam Township and Village of Pinckney only. Filled bags should be left at the side of the road for pickup by our contractor on Monday, April 29. Items that are too large to fit in the bags should be left next to the bags. Bags should be clearly visible from the road; please only use the bright yellow bags we provide in the Cleanup Kits.

Teams may collect bottles or cans and return for deposit money, using their own, or a yellow bag that we supply.

Junk removal. Putnam Township, Village of Pinckney and Unadilla Township residents are welcome. *Prohibited items:*
